

## Mixed Colours

Dreadnought offer the widest range of natural tile colours in both smooth and sandfaced finish available today. They are available both as a mono colour such as Staffordshire Blue or Plum Red and also as multi coloured tiles such as Brown Antique, Country Brown and Red/Blue Blend.

However, an individual more complex effect can be achieved by mixing tiles of different colours together. Whereas mixing artificial colours can look clumsy and contrived, mixing Dreadnought colours produces a natural blend of compatible shades. These are some examples of popular tile mixes.
